Trip Information

WEDNESDAY 16 APRIL - Leaving school at 9.45 am, we will stroll down to Waipapa Landing and have morning tea by the river. We will relax by Waipapa River and find a good spot to hunt eels. We will take some bait and nets for those who are keen to try their hand at catching an eel - no hooks. There will be lots of helpers. We will stroll back to school, aiming to be back by 2pm. Children will need shoes, sunhats, clothing suitable for time in the sun, lunch, and a drink. This trip is dependent on good weather and safe river levels.



WEDNESDAY 23 APRIL - IN-LINE SKATING AT THE WAIPAPA STADIUM

Leaving OSCAR at 9.45am, we'll have a couple of hours at the Bay Sport Stadium in Waipapa, using in-line skates from the Kerikeri Inline Skating Club. Children are welcome to bring their own skates if they have them. There is a sprung floor and a beginners' area, so helmets are not usually needed. Children will be hungry by the time we get back for lunch. Children will need LONG, THICK SOCKS and something warm to wear afterwards. The bus will collect us at 12midday, returning to OSCAR for lunch.
