



★ **Hui at Whitiara Marae – Term 4**

★ In collaboration with Kerikeri Primary, Kerikeri High School, Bay of Islands International Academy and Harvest Christian School, we have been working with Ngāti Rehia, the Ministry of Education, and other education experts to review the Aotearoa Histories Curriculum, and what this looks like for our Kura. Next term we will have a hui at Whitiara Marae to have a korero about this and gain whānau voice from across Kerikeri, to help support all kura to cater to the need of all tamariki to the best of our ability. Once a date is set, we will let whānau know.

★ **Enrolments for 2025**

★ In 2025 we have predicted the roll to start at around 400 students and increasing to approximately 450.
★ If you know of someone moving into our school zone and they are interested in coming to Riverview School, please get them to request an enrolment pack from the office and visit our amazing school. We are more than happy to show anyone around and to look at our school culture.

★ **New Class Update:**

★ We are still planning on having the new class delivered to school in the holidays. Once this is in place, the fit-out will commence. There has been no estimated time that this will be completed.
★ The MOE have also confirmed that we have been approved for a second ‘additional class’. This is at the beginning stages, and there is no timeline for this yet.

★ **Classes 2025**

★ We are beginning to plan for the 2025 year, including that of **2025 class placements**. Organising class lists is very complicated and time consuming.

★ Families do not have the option of choosing either a teacher or a class simply as a preference. We believe that we know your tamariki well and ask you to trust us with the class placements, and children that they should or should not be with in a class. However, if you have some information that you believe is important in regards to your child’s class placement (e.g. not with another child they may have ongoing issues with), please email myself directly about this, by Friday 27 September, so that the information can feed into our planning. School Bus Routes and Stops

Recently, we have been asked about the location of the school bus stops. These are set by the Kerikeri Transport Network who manage our school buses. Bus stops have to be safe places for students to get on and off the bus as well as safe places for the bus to pull into and then pull back onto the road from. The visibility of the driver to see the road and any hazards is of utmost importance. This may mean that the bus stop is not as close to your house or may even be on a different street.

The Ministry of Education sets guidelines for safety of students on school bus routes. Schools ensure that students get on the bus after school and set the rules for all students to be seated, facing forward and wearing a seatbelt if one is available. Students are told not to distract the driver and to remain seated for the ride.

Parents must ensure children get to and from the bus stop safely and care for them at the bus stop. This means that all students should be taken to the bus stop by a parent or caregiver and this person should see them get on the bus. After school, a parent or caregiver should be at the bus stop to meet their child. It is the parent's responsibility to get children safely to and from the bus stop.

We are working with all the schools in our local area to ensure safe transport for your children. Please support us by reminding children about safe behaviour on and around the school bus.

Riverview School Out-of-Zone Enrolments for 2025

The Board of Trustees invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their children at Riverview School for next year.

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school website.

Please download the enrolment form off the school website www.riverview.school.nz and email to admin@riverview.school.nz with relevant documentation.

The deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is **Tuesday 15 October 2024**.

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year.

The board has determined that 1 place is likely to be available for out-of-zone new entrant students for 2025. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot is required, it will be held on **Wednesday 23 October 2024**. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

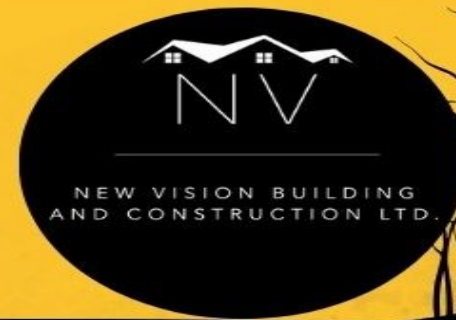

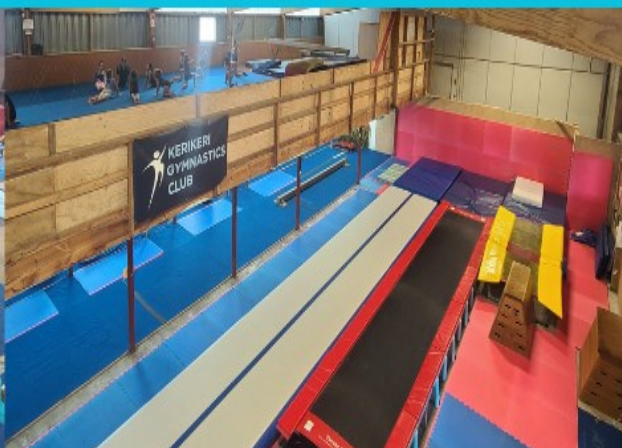
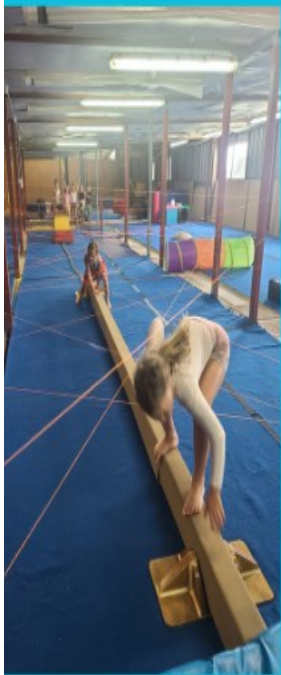
